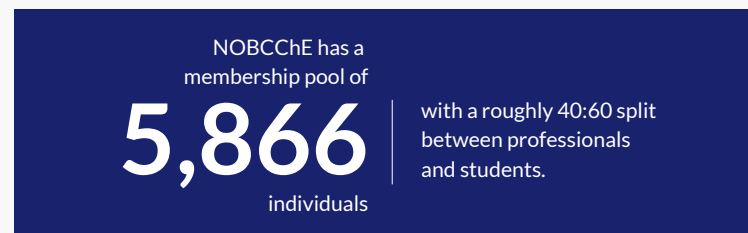

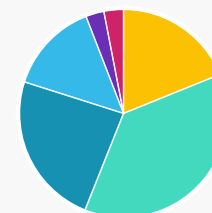
Most attendees at the 2023 NOBCChE Meeting participated to search for jobs, gain insights into career paths, and network with potential employers and fellow attendees.

NOBCChE Member Demographics



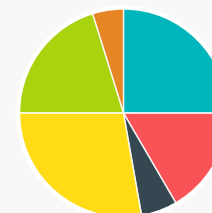
Employment Sectors
